Advanced Topics in Uniform Guidance Content Level: Advanced

Course Description

The Uniform Guidance was implemented in December 2014. The then Controller of the Office of Management Budget, (OMB), lauded it as "Transforming the Landscape of Federal Financial Assistance." How transformational the UG is will be debated for years to come, but understanding the intricacies of the regulations will assist Research Administrators and Principal Investigators in ensuing compliance, while easing some of the administrative burden on researchers.

This workshop goes beyond the basics by using case studies and recent audits to explore the interpretation of the regulations. When faced with a questioned cost, what evidence can you use to support your decisions? The reality is that we live in a world of gray and most decisions made are on a case-by-case basis, weighing heavily on the documentation at hand and adding a little 'common sense' methodology. The Uniform Guidance allows room for interpretation. Come join your colleagues for discussions on how to handle some of the tough questions on the allowability of costs. We will share best practices and ideas for improving compliance.
